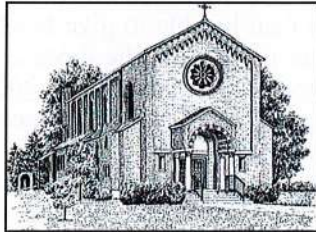

## FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO



Saturday, April 13, the Troops of St. George braved the cold rain and wind at St. Francis Cemetery and St. Agnes Cemetery in order to prepare the grounds for the mowing season. They persevered and got the job done. They will have a reward in heaven, but in anticipation of that, they were rewarded with pizza in the garage at St. Felix.

We have several other initiatives and events to look forward to. First, in a few weeks, we will begin a census process to update the contact information for our parishioners. You may have seen the article in the Catholic Courier about this initiative from the diocese. We were chosen as one of the 'pilot parishes,' as we will then be able to give feedback on the process for all the other parishes in the diocese as they take their census throughout the remainder of 2024. The reason is that we simply need a better way to contact people. Many times we have looked for phone numbers in our ParishSoft system (the database for registered parishioners) only to find that the landline number they gave us for their registration 30+ years ago is no longer in use. The same goes for email addresses. There will be a simple survey that can be accessed on a phone or computer that is submitted electronically. There will also be a paper copy if someone would prefer that. All of this information will be given more clearly and thoroughly in the coming weeks. I thank you in advance for your participation.



Second, last weekend I mentioned the plan for this year's *Corpus Christi* celebration. We are in the heart of the Eucharistic Revival initiated by our country's bishops. This is a perfect opportunity to take our annual *Corpus Christi* procession to the next level by bringing the community together, not just for worship, but fellowship, a natural extension of our communion in Christ. And so, we are planning a Parish Picnic/Cookout following the Mass and Procession at St. Dominic. The plan is to have a 10:00 AM Mass at St. Dominic on Sunday, June 2, followed by the Procession to Brookside Cemetery. This will all conclude at about noon, and we will all be ready to eat by then. It is also a great opportunity to invite some friends from other parishes.



There is plenty more going on, but one last event to put on your radar is Catholic speaker Paul Zucarelli will be coming to give his presentation at our parish. Paul had a near-death experience after sudden cardiac arrest and met Christ. His story is fascinating and inspiring, and he has travelled all over, appeared on all kinds of Catholic media, to give his testimony. He will be visiting us for an evening on Monday, June 10, to tell us about his experiences. I want to thank Donna Wieand from Branches Retreat Center for making this happen. 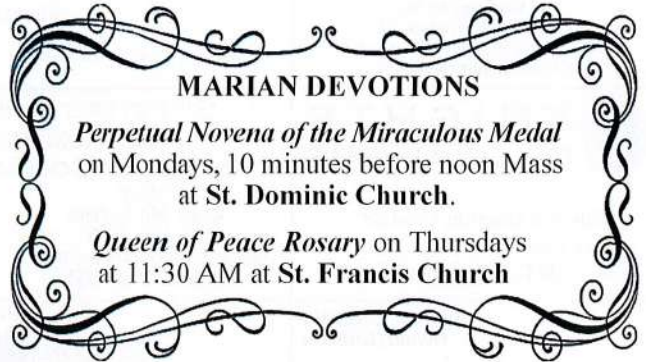
