FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

As we come now to the Third Sunday of Advent, the rose vestments are worn to signal to us that something is different. The violet vestments speak to us of penance, while the rose vestments lighten the mood for us as the Lord is near.

In fact, we hear these very words in today's *Introit* (Entrance Antiphon) that is chanted at the beginning of the Mass: "Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice! For the Lord is near." We refer to this Sunday as "*Gaudete*" Sunday because the first words of the Mass, as given in the Entrance Antiphon, in Latin, are: "Gaudéte in Dómino semper: iterum dico, gaudéte. Dóminus enim prope est." The Church calls us to rejoice because the Lord whom we have so longed for is about to come again, and the joy and peace that we know at Christmas will hopefully come to us again this season.

There is also a great tradition on this Third Sunday of Advent. In Italy, children would have a little figure of the Christ Child that would go in the manger, called the "Bambinelli." They would make a trip to Rome to St. Peter's Square and the Holy Father blesses the Bambinelli, the children, and their families. Here is a prayer that can be prayed around your own manger scene, and should be prayed by the father in each home:

God our Father, you loved us so much you sent us your only Son, Jesus, born of the Virgin Mary, to save us and lead us back to you.

We pray that, with your blessing, these images of Jesus might be a sign of your presence and love in our homes.

Good Father, give your blessing to all who gather with us this Christmas, family and friends.

Open our hearts, that we might receive Jesus in joy, always do what He asks of us, and see Him in those who need our love. Amen.

Finally, we can contemplate the words of Dom Prosper Guéranger on this Gaudete Sunday:

"There is no time to lose: *the Lord is nigh!* If these lines should come under the eye of any of those Christians who are in the state of sinful indifference, we would conjure them to shake off their lethargy, and render themselves worthy of the visit of the divine Infant: such a visit will bring them the greatest consolation here, and give them confidence hereafter, when our Lord will come to judge all mankind.

Send Thy grace, O Jesus, still more plentifully into their hearts...

During the Offertory the faithful should unite in the prayer of the Church, and beg that the captivity in which our sins hold us may be brought to an end, and that the divine Deliverer may come."




