

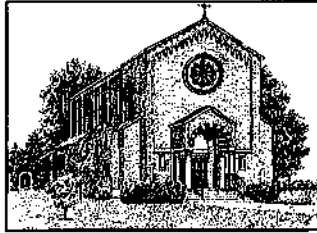

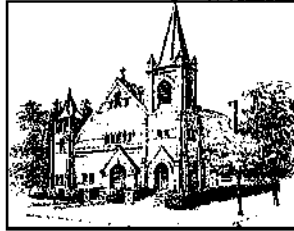

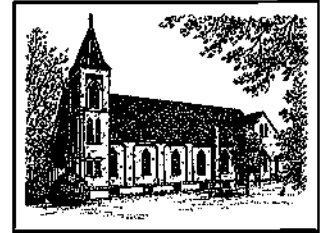

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

As we continue our close look at the prayers of the Roman Canon (Eucharistic Prayer I), we come to the final section of the first long prayer before we lead up to the Consecration. This prayer is called the *Communicantes* (from its first word in Latin) and I separated it into three sections to highlight the different categories of saints:

In communion with those whose memory we venerate, especially the glorious ever-Virgin Mary, Mother of our God and Lord, Jesus Christ, and blessed Joseph, her Spouse,

your blessed Apostles and Martyrs, Peter and Paul, Andrew, (James, John, Thomas, James, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Simon and Jude;

Linus, Cletus, Clement, Sixtus, Cornelius, Cyprian, Laurence, Chrysogonus, John and Paul, Cosmas and Damian) and all your Saints; we ask that through their merits and prayers, in all things we may be defended by your protecting help. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

“*Communicantes*” is translated for us as “In communion with,” but we can also say “sharing with” or something similar. The idea is that the saints in heaven are not separate from us in this act of worship. We participate in the life of the Communion of Saints. Every Mass is a true act of Sacrifice and a participation in the worship of the Eternal Father in heaven, where the saints worship right now. At Mass, we join them (the Church Triumphant) in adoration. We also honor them for what they have done by example (and continue to do by intercession) for the Church on earth (the Church Militant).

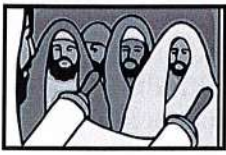


The first place is, of course, given to the Mother of God, Mary. Interestingly, St. Joseph was only added in 1962, by Pope John XXIII. Then we are given the names of the Twelve Apostles and twelve other saints, all martyrs (except the Apostle John). The names in parentheses are optional in the current Missal, but it is beautiful nonetheless to always invoke their names as a constant reminder of our connection with the earliest days of the Faith. All of these saints listed here (in its beautiful symmetry) were venerated in Rome and lived in the first four centuries. This should help us appreciate the antiquity of this prayer as it has been handed down to us since at least the early sixth century. One advantage of the other Eucharistic Prayers is that they allow a place for inserting saints of more local significance, rather than a strictly fixed litany.

After the Apostles, we are given five popes after St. Peter, and then a bishop (Cyprian), a deacon (Lawrence), and five lay men (Chrysogonus taught St. Anastasia, who we will see later in the Canon). We therefore see *the entire Church on earth represented here* by those who now reign in heaven, living forever to intercede for us. This prayer not only calls upon the help of heaven to assist us in a worthy Sacrifice to God but also reminds us of our true dignity and destiny as Christians made for the glory of heaven, as at this point in the Mass, the priest is now prepared to call heaven down upon the altar as the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ.

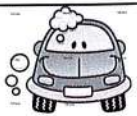
