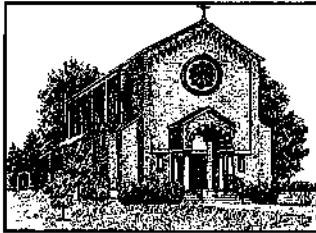

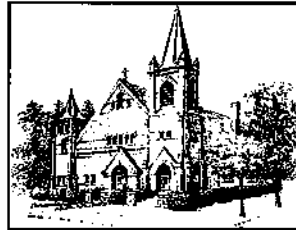

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Happy Father's Day to all our fathers throughout the parish! God bless you for your love and sacrifice in order to raise your families. Be assured of my continued prayers for you and all our families throughout the parish!

This past week we welcomed a very special guest speaker, Paul Zucarelli. I was so happy to see how many people came to this event, from many parishes in our area and from the Rochester area as well. We used almost every chair we had in the Parish Center!

I was impressed with Paul's knowledge and fluency with Sacred Scripture as he navigated us through the events of his life from a rather faithful husband and father, and successful businessman, to a fervent evangelist and preacher of Christ Crucified and Risen.

He was always someone who read Scripture, but the Word took on new meaning and intensity as he faced his own mortality with a serious heart condition, and a surgery which he was not guaranteed to survive. He survived the surgery, but before even leaving the hospital he went into cardiac arrest and had a Near Death Experience. Such experiences are now well-documented in scientific literature. Some features of these experiences include the ability to see one's own body "from above" while everyone around is working to revive him. Some experiences include knowledge of what people are doing and saying who are not present with the body at the time. Further, the person's soul is drawn away from the body and engulfed in an indescribable light and peace that is most often described as being in the presence of God. There may also be a "life review" where God reminds one of the sins of one's life as He prepares to send the person back into his body so that he can continue his mission in this life.

Paul experienced these things, and it changed his life. In that one weekend after his surgery, he experienced *nine cardiac arrests* and was deprived of oxygen to his brain for about two hours. This would normally cause one to remain in a "vegetative state" for the rest of his life, but from what only could be called a miracle, Paul retained completely normal functioning of his brain and body. From then on, he knew that nothing else mattered other than preparing for Heaven, and that his mission in life would be to share his story and help others to prepare for eternity, whenever God chooses to take us to Himself.

There is so much more to Paul's story than what I could describe here or even what he could give during his talk last week. If you are looking for some good, inspiring reading, please obtain a copy of his book *Faith Understood: An Ordinary Man's Journey to the Presence of God*. All proceeds from sales go towards various charities, including donations to various religious orders.
