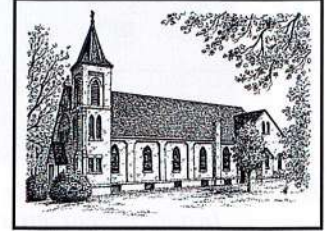

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO



Heavenly Father, Lord of the harvest, call forth vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life from our parishes. We must continue to pray for vocations to the priesthood in our diocese. Without priests, there is no Mass, no absolution through Confession, no anointing of the sick. While the situation we are in can seem dire at times, we are given beautiful moments of consolation and hope.

This past Sunday we were so honored to host the annual Seminarian Picnic at St. Dominic Church, following the 12:00pm Mass. Most of our seminarians were present and serving the Mass, while our newly ordained Deacon George Bastedo preached on vocations and the formation of our young people in the home.

We often see the seminarian poster each year and, often, they are just faces to us. At Mass on Sunday, we saw these men in various stages of formation for the priesthood (some just beginning in a few weeks). Then we gathered to eat with them, meet the parents of some of them who were present, and become acquainted with the men who, God willing, someday will be serving our diocese as priests.

I want to express my deep gratitude to Deacon Dermot and Janene Loughran for taking the lead and organizing this event each year. It started several years ago at their home, when it was a much smaller gathering with just a few families. Now, it is a celebration for our diocese and an opportunity for our seminarians to catch just a snapshot of the people for whom they will be sacrificing their lives; for whom they will spend long hours in study and prayer. And it is a reminder for us priests, too, that while we have been given a particular parish to care for, we are priests of a diocese filled with so many people who rely on Christ's ministry through His Church.

Thank you, as well, to our Knights of Columbus who provided the pulled pork for the event and managed the set-up and clean-up for this wonderful afternoon! We are also thankful for the help received from the Knights from St. Benedict and St. Jerome Parishes.
