

Last week, we hosted our annual Vacation Bible School and the children had a great time! First, I want to thank Sarah and all who volunteered their time to teach and to have their children there. It takes a lot of time and effort to plan such a week, with all the materials and activities involved. I was there on the final day to answer whatever questions the children had. I showed them the relic of St. Dominic, and one group wanted to ring the bells the see the choir loft, as I attempted to play the organ.



similar in St. Paul's Second Letter to Timothy:

This year's theme was "Cathletics – Training to be Champions for Christ." I like this theme because we have to realize that a life of virtue and sanctity is not a one-time act, but a lifelong journey, a marathon, with the heavenly goal before our eyes keeping us going. It is a choice each day to continue to follow Christ. St. Paul tells us this truth:

"Do you not know that the runners in the stadium all run in the race, but only one wins the prize? Run so as to win. Every athlete exercises discipline in every way. They do it to win a perishable crown, but we an imperishable one. Thus I do not run aimlessly; I do not fight as if I were shadowboxing. No, I drive my body and train it, for fear that, after having preached to others, I myself should be disqualified."
(1 Corinthians 9:24-27)

A race is not won by simply choosing to run. Each day is preparation for what comes to us that day. We are constantly training and growing in our discipline of prayer and penitential practices. We see something

"I have competed well; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith. From now on the crown of righteousness awaits me, which the Lord, the just judge, will award to me on that day, and not only to me, but to all who have longed for his appearance." (2 Timothy 4:7-8)

To give these teachings to the children, they learned the Ten Commandments, the Beatitudes, the virtue of Excellence, and the Cardinal Virtues of Prudence, Justice, Temperance, and Fortitude. Besides learning more abstract ideas, it is important for us to learn the lives of the saints to see how this looks in a real person in some particular time and place. This is why the children also learned about Pope St. John Paul II, St. Anne, Blessed Pierre Giorgio Frassati, St. Marguerite D'Youville and St. Francis Xavier. The saints instantiate the life of the Gospel and so they give us an example to follow, whether they are the great kings and queens, or popes, or of the most humble walks of life, and everything in between.

It was a beautiful week for the children to be together and grow in their understanding and love of our Faith. Please pray that they continue to grow each day in their faith, and that this year's VBS will be a lasting part of their journey.




