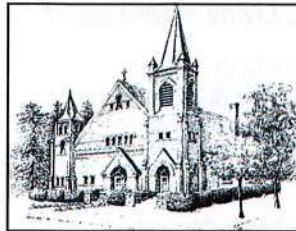

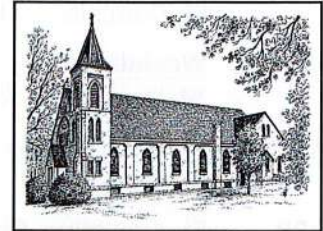

Month Five - DEVELOPING BABY Spiritual Adoption Program 2022

From April 8 to December 25
(Feast of the Annunciation to Christmas)
