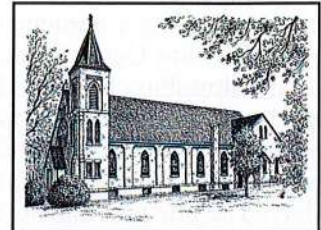

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

At the end of September, we will be very privileged to host the area's first Enrollment into the Angelic Warfare Confraternity. **On Saturday, September 28, immediately following the 4:00pm Mass**, I will celebrate the rite of enrollment for anyone interested. Over the next few weeks, I will be giving more information.



For now, it is important to be reminded what a confraternity is. Similar to being enrolled in the Brown Scapular, the Angelic Warfare Confraternity is a type of supernatural fellowship of believers united around pursuing a particular goal together. The Angelic Warfare Confraternity (AWC) “is a supernatural fellowship of men and women bound to one another in love and *dedicated to pursuing and promoting chastity together* under the powerful patronage St. Thomas Aquinas and the Blessed Virgin Mary. The title of ‘Angelic Warfare’ honors St. Thomas being girded by the angels. But the name is also appropriate because the pursuit of chastity is often a fierce struggle with the world, the flesh, and the devil. The world, the flesh, and the devil all work together to destroy chastity. *The Holy Spirit, the good angels, and the confraternity work together to build up chastity.*”

The Order of Preachers (the Dominicans), promote this confraternity all over the world under the patronage of St. Thomas Aquinas and the Blessed Virgin Mary. The importance of chastity as related to the life of St. Thomas is crucial here. He was born in 1226, as the youngest in his family, and they did not want him to follow the new religious order established by St. Dominic. They did everything they could to get him to change his mind, even locking him up in their own jail until he relented. He was determined, and so

Finally, after becoming tired of waiting, the brothers of St. Thomas conceived one last plan. They were certain that physical temptation would drive him to break his vow of chastity, after which he would surely abandon his religious vocation. So one night, the brothers introduced a scantily clad prostitute into the room where St. Thomas was being held. The plan did not work as intended. Immediately, St. Thomas snatched a burning brand from the hearth, drove the woman out of the room, slammed the door behind her, and emblazoned the sign of the cross on the door with the red-hot brand. He then fell to his knees with tears of thanksgiving and prayed to be preserved in his chastity, his purity, and his intention to live the religious life as a son of St. Dominic.

According to the records of his canonization, Thomas fell at once into a mystical sleep and had a vision. Two angels came to him from heaven and bound a cord around his waist, saying, “On God’s behalf, we gird you with the girdle of chastity, a girdle which no attack will ever destroy.” In the records of his canonization, many different witnesses who knew St. Thomas at different points in his life remarked about his evidently high degree of purity and chastity. The angels’ gift preserved St. Thomas from sexual temptation and bestowed upon him an enduring purity that ennobled all his thoughts and actions. Over his lifetime, St. Thomas’s conduct revealed that he had indeed received a special grace of chastity and purity—a grace that he is now ready to share with others through the communion of saints.

And so, St. Thomas is now known as the “Angelic Doctor.” I will write more on this in the coming weeks, but I believe this is great opportunity for our parish, and those throughout the diocese, to join together for holy purity, under the patronage of the greatest of Dominican saints, St. Thomas Aquinas.
