FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

This week, from Sunday evening until Friday evening, I will be away on my yearly retreat. I ask for your good prayers for my safe travels and that the retreat is fruitful and renewing for me. I always look forward to this time for a retreat, something I should probably do more than once per year. It is not that I like being away, but that the time I am given to pray and read, and just generally be quiet, is re-energizing, so that I can continue a fruitful ministry.

One might ask: "What do you do on a retreat?" Many retreats that we may advertise in the area are more "guided" retreats. This is where there is someone leading the retreat and usually preaching on a particular topic over a series of several talks. There is time for Mass and Confessions, and typically time for community among the fellow retreatants. The time should also include silence to give a chance for reflection that we may not normally experience in our daily lives.

For myself, I prefer a more solitary retreat. This is where I can live by my own routine/rule for a week without interruption and have ample time to read what I do not usually have time to read. Part of my vocation discernment came through my academic work as an undergraduate and graduate student, and so I know I need time for intellectual stimulation and for reading more academic books.

My day while on retreat is rather rigorous, but still relaxing. I will wake up very early and pray my Holy Hour, as I always do. Then I say Mass, eat breakfast, and continue my prayer schedule of the Liturgy of the Hours/Divine Office throughout the day. In between the parts of the Divine Office, is time for reading or taking a walk while praying the Rosary. In a monastic setting, the Liturgy of the Hours punctuates the various parts of the day by prayer as the work of the day is done in between those times of prayer. In the silence, there is reflection, contemplation, and prayer. Silence can force us to look inward, because without the external distractions, there is nowhere else to go. This is the value of a retreat.

Finally, at the end of this coming week, on June 29, I celebrate my third anniversary at this parish! I could not be more grateful to all of you in my time here as your pastor. I know that I always have to grow in various ways, and I have seen various kinds of communities amongst the eleven churches that I have served in these seven short years, but I always strive to love the best I can. Thank you for all of your support, prayers, and love over these past three years.

Be assured of my prayers for all of you while I am away on retreat, and I will see you next weekend!




